Project background

This three-year project with the Bairnsdale BestWool/BestLamb group demonstrates best practice sheep worm management in East Gippsland.

As part of this project, several East Gippsland producers have undertaken Worm Egg Count Reduction Testing (WECRT), more commonly known as drench resistance testing, to identify the level of drench efficacy in their flocks.

This webinar will give an overview of the results and outline why knowing the drench resistance status of your flock is important management tool.
